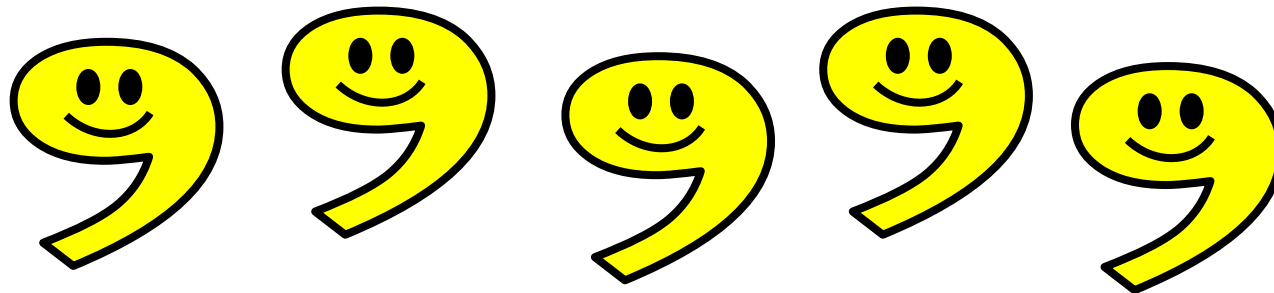

Possessive Noun Task Cards

Here are 32 task cards to help your students learn to properly punctuate and identify singular and plural possessive nouns. Each card requires students to both write the possessive noun correctly (by adding the apostrophe), and to tell whether the word is singular or plural. Several of these cards are quite challenging. Tricky words have been used such as *princesses'* and *wolves'*. Further, for some cards students must look for clues in the sentence to determine whether the noun is singular or plural. Also, note that for singular possessive nouns that end in "s" (bus, class), two answers are acceptable.

A student answer sheet and an answer key is included, as well as three Challenge Cards which can be used to extend the activity. These task cards are perfect for test prep and will work well at literacy centers, stations, for partner work, or with the whole class using a game like Scoot.

While this product is aligned with the following third grade Common Core Standard, the level of difficulty makes it appropriate for fourth and fifth grade as well.

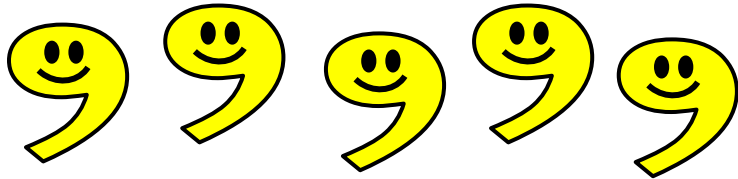

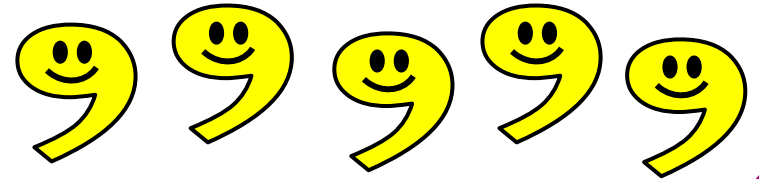

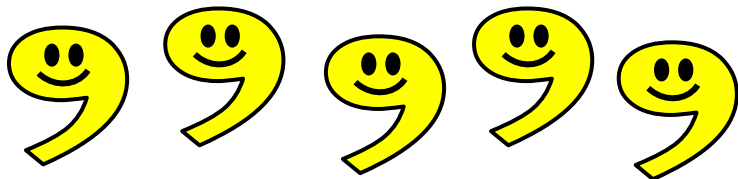

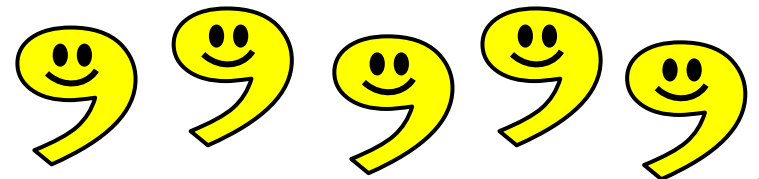
