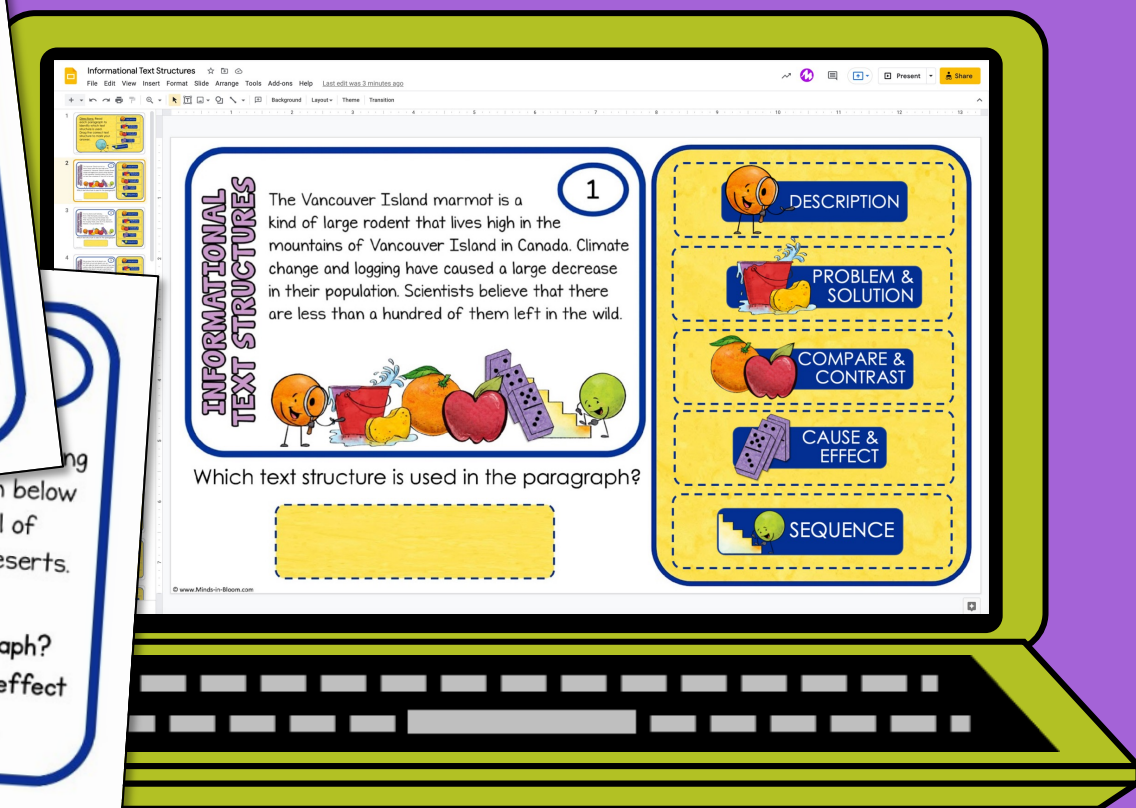
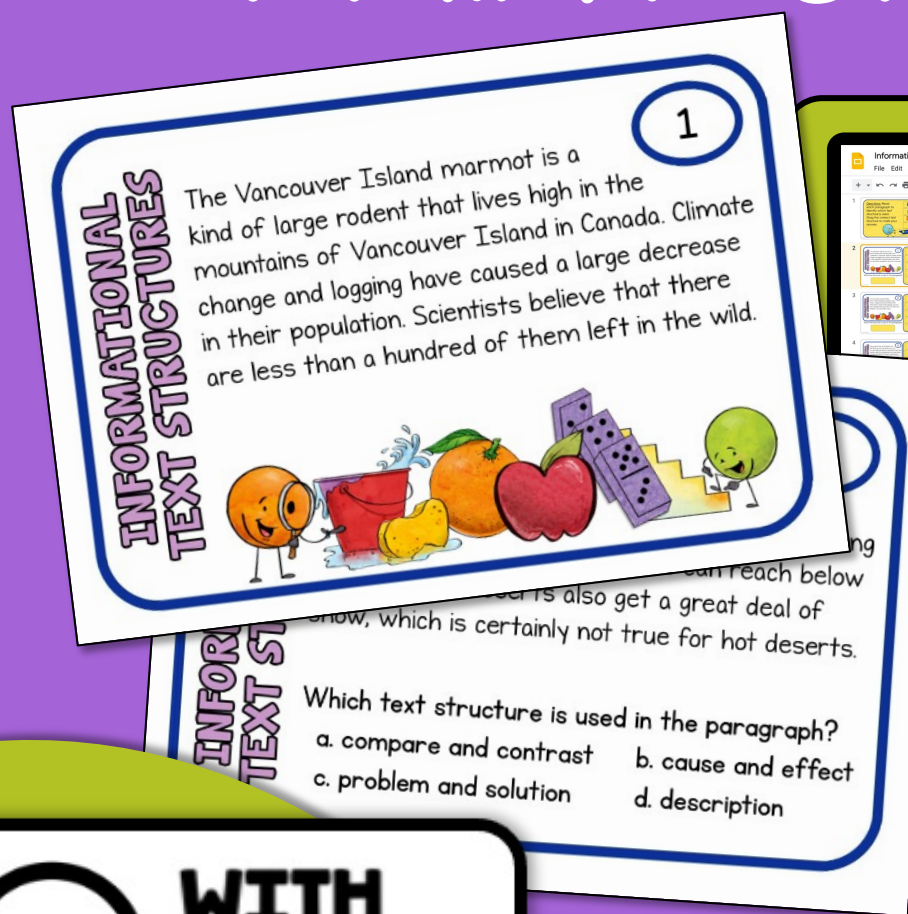

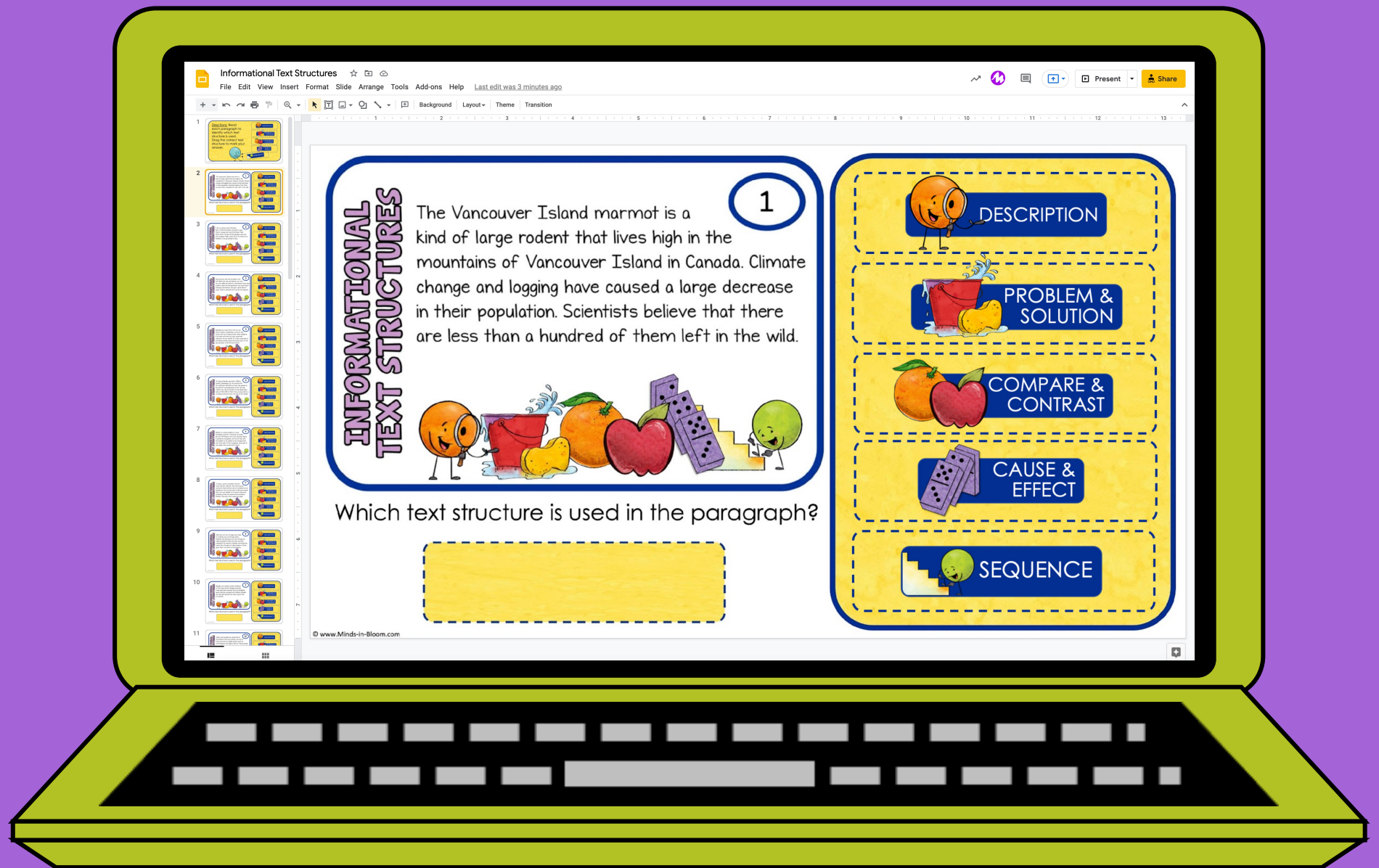

## 32 Task Cards
